



Term of Use

1. General

Welcome to the terms of use for the Falkonair free website, including the website accessible at <http://www.falkonair.com> (hereinafter the "Site"), and its desktop, tablet, and mobile applications (hereinafter the "application").

The site and application are created, developed and operated by Falkonair Inc. (hereinafter "FALKONAIR") a US corporation listed in the Trade and Companies Register under number P20000008010, the registered office of which is located at 8984 Alexandra Circle, Wellington, FL 33414.

To access and use the Falkonair free website, you need to accept our data protection and cookies act.

The copy of the site is only authorised for a personal and private use, therefore any other use, particularly in public premises, legal activity and for businesses, is strictly forbidden.

2. Intellectual property
